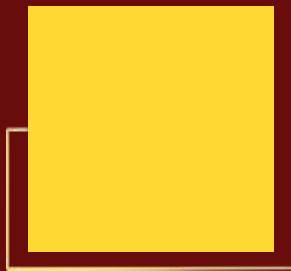
Please Note:

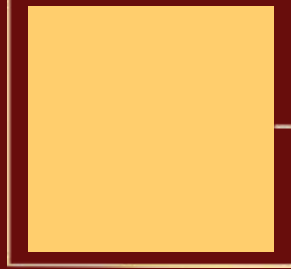

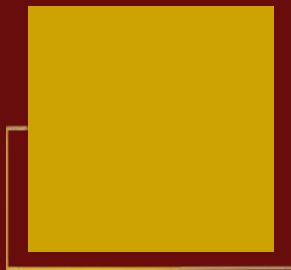
